It was agreed that Michael Tagent be chairman.

Friends of All Hallows

Michael reported that there were 31 Friends, including 6 Life Friends. Receipts totalled just over £2,000, of which £1,500 related to Life Friends. Income in future would thus be in the order of £500 per annum. Letters had been sent to those on the church electoral roll, then to other parishioners; e-mail messages had also been sent to overseas churches with the same dedication as Ringmore, but without response. Letters would now be sent to people with past connections with All Hallows; Rosemary had listed names from the church registers and other names were welcomed; details to be given to Yvonne.

It was agreed to send out a Friends Newsletter in November 2002, then annually in January from 2004. The first Friends Festival would be in July 2003 and might include a Bat Watch.

The next meeting would consider the desirability of inviting someone to be President of the Friends of All Hallows and, if so, what their powers, duties and method of election might be.

Open Gardens Day: Sunday July 14

Nine gardens will be open from 12 noon to 5 p.m. (The Lodge, The Scypen, Walnut Tree Cottage, Hillside House, The Fairway, Challaborough Cottage, Cliff Path, 2 Crossways and End House). Each owner to be asked to provide by June 14 a 30-word write-up, plus two questions for a children's quiz.

Visitors to park to be in Ann Lambell's field and "check in" at the W.I. Hall, paying £5 per adult (children free). This will give entry to all gardens, entry to the children's quiz and unlimited tea/coffee/squash. The "ticket" to be in the form of a brochure with map and write-up of each garden.

Posters and handouts to be sent to local churches, information and garden centres; Rosemary to circulate details in Modbury. Details were in the June parish and diocesan newsletters; Yvonne to contact local press/radio.

A plant stall and "jardin du vin" to be in Rosemary's garden (liquor licence is from 2 to 5 p.m.). The children's quiz to be two (easy!) questions from each owner, with a lollipop for each child who hands in a paper (by 5 p.m. at the W.I. Hall). First five correct sheets win £1 each.

Refreshments to be a variety of ploughman's lunches (£3 each) and cream teas (£1.50 for scone with jam/cream and cake).

Open air service at Middle Manor (in barn if wet) at 6 p.m.

Owners and helpers to have preview at 3 p.m. on Sunday July 7, starting/finishing at Challaborough Cottage. Social at 2 Crossways after open air service (eats/wine); to be announced at preview.

Yvonne: arrange preview with owners and helpers

Michael: provide drinks for preview
