1981 The Ecclesiastical Parish consists of the Civil Parishes of Ringmore and Kingston. The Civil Census count for these two Civil Parishes were 230 and 310 respectively, so the Ecclesiastical Parish population in 1981 was \_\_\_\_\_540

1983 Between 1981 and 1983 no houses were built at Ringmore and the population of "usual residents" dropped to 210. During the same time, 7 houses were built at Kingston and the population there rose to 345, so the population of the Ecclesiastical Parish in 1983 was \_\_\_\_\_555

1991 According to the Modbury District Plan there could be up to 5 houses built in infill sites at Ringmore, and up to 18 more houses built at Kingston, to increase the population there by about 22 people. At Ringmore 15% of the 1981 housing stock was in second and holiday homes and 9% at Kingston. Altogether, the "usual resident" population may be expected to increase by about 28 by 1991 to give a population of, say, \_\_\_\_\_583
