Two areas, one now full, used for cremated remains.

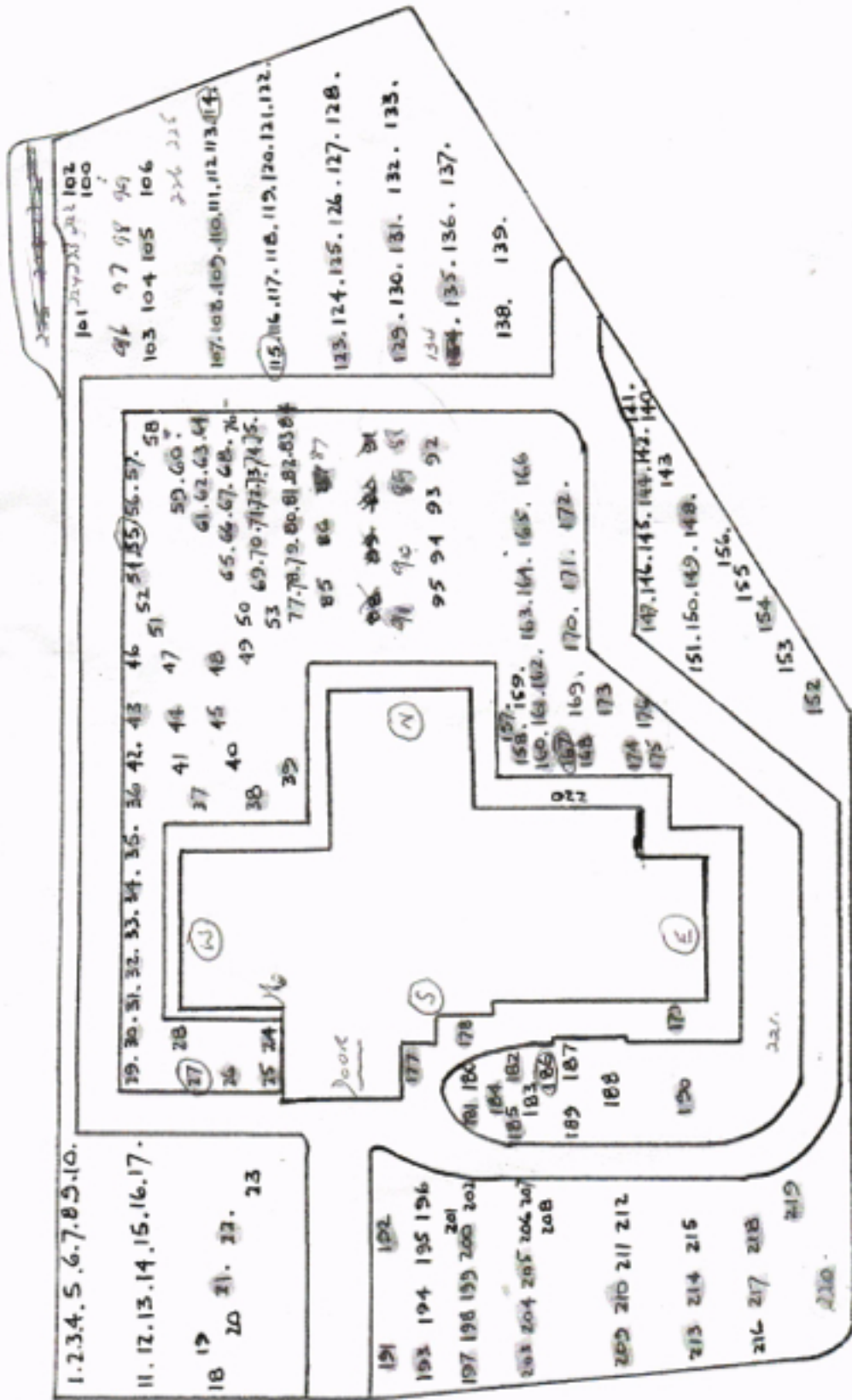
1. South west corner to the corner of the path at S.W. corner of the church.

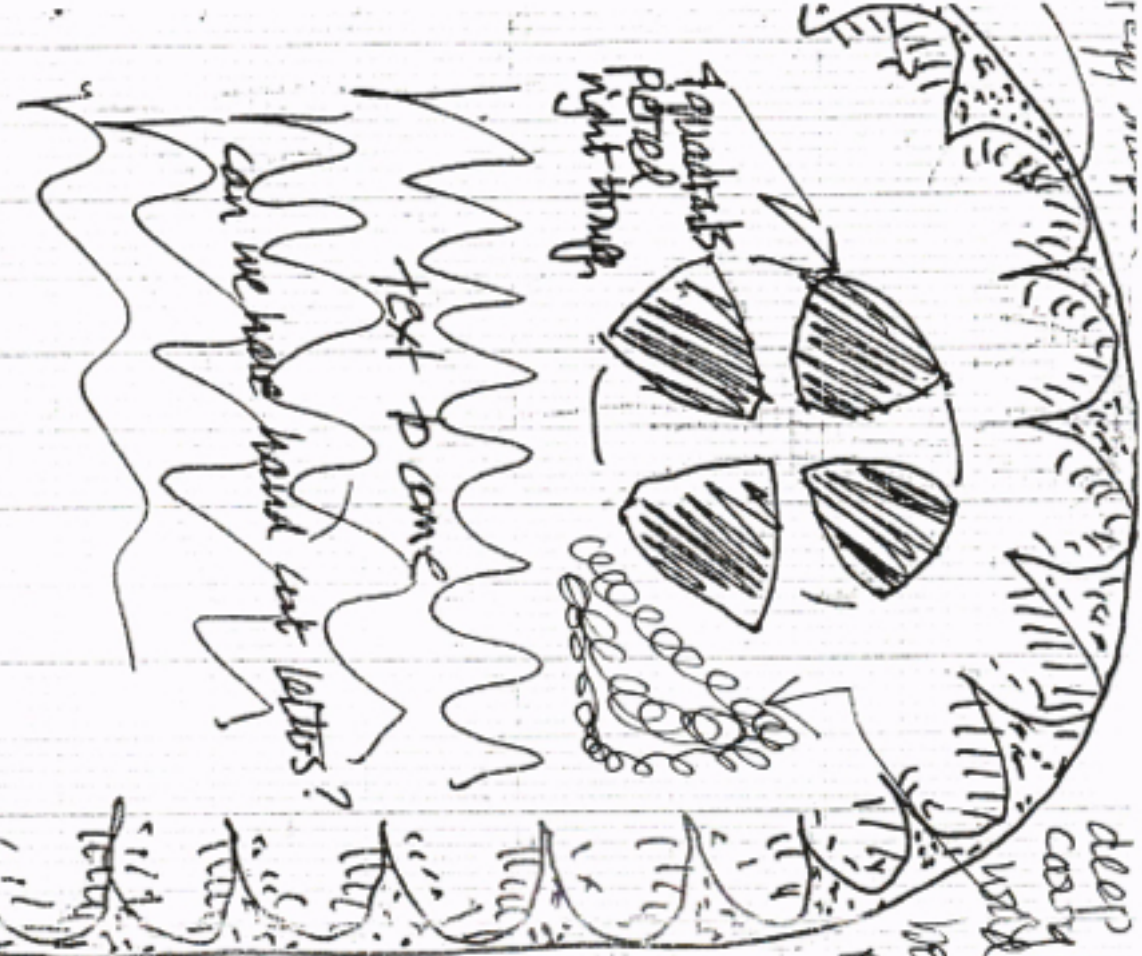

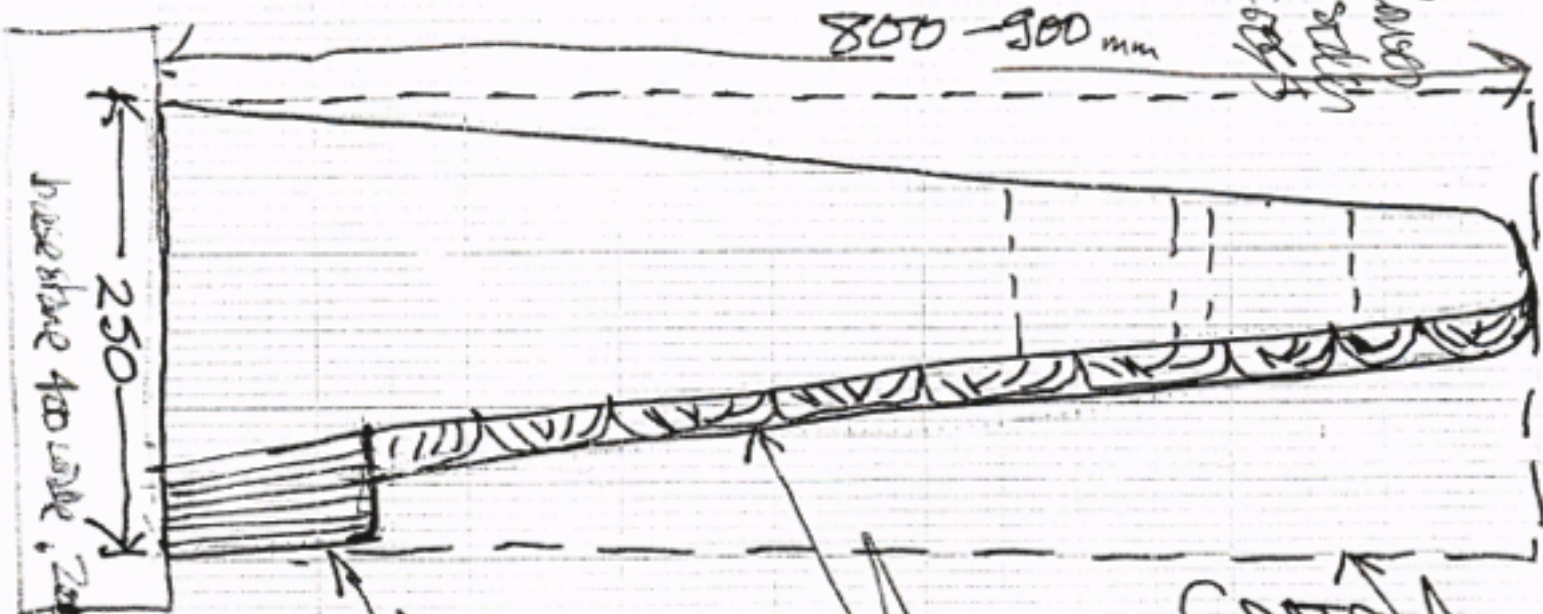
