- 1396 The late Nicholas Kirk ham : feoffment to Sir John Chudleigh, John Hull of Exeter and John Durburgh patrons for John Stancombe 17 June 1396
- 1434 Robert Kirkham presented William Palmer 2 October 1434
- 1465 Nicholas Kirkham presented Thomas Der(v?)y 28 June 1465
- 1472 Patron: William Yeo, Esq. [Why the change of surname?]
- 1546 (sometime before this date) John Kirkham, Kt. presented Edward Hillersdon
- 1555 George Kirkham, Esq., presented Nicholas Coote
- 1637 Sir William Kirkham of Blagdon,, Kent. He had granted the presentation to Francis Torkington (1585-1637)
- 1663 George Kirkham, Esq., of Pinhoe presented George Reynall
- 1697 Francis Kirkham of Bidwell in Newton St.Cyres (29 March 1697) Patron to Thomas Heskett (Rector till 1759)
- N.B. The manor was sold by Francis Kirkham sometime between 1754 and 1758 to Thomas Roe

Francis Kirkham made a gift to the poor of Ringmore of alms houses in 1768 George Grimshaw then makes a note : (See Charity Commissioners 1826)
