

ALL HALLOWS RINGMORE

Burials recorded 1039
Ages recorded 683

From 1600 to 1737 no ages are recorded.

From 1738 to 2001 683 ages are recorded being 66% of all burials.

In the century 1800 to 1900 all ages are recorded.

In the century 1900 to 2000 92% of ages are recorded.

From 1600 to 1700 few burials are recorded.

In the century 1800 to 1900 children under 10 represent 23% of all burials.

Ignoring cremations, changes in the size of the village population, and of the Church catchment area, the villagers appear to be living longer in 1900-2000 than earlier. This trend is in line with the known increase in longevity of the county as a whole.

The oldest recorded burial is that of Nicholas Eliot on the 30th of August 1602.

From 1600 to 1737 no ages are recorded.

From 1738 to 2001 683 ages are recorded, being 66% of all burials recorded.

In the century 1800-1900 all ages are recorded.

In the century 1900-2000 92% of ages are recorded.

From 1600 to 1700 few burials are recorded.

In the century 1800-1900 the ages of children under 10 are 23% of all burials in that century.

The ages of children under 10 are 15% of all burials.

Ignoring exhumations, changes in the size of the village population and of the church's "catchment area", the villagers seemed to be living longer in 1900-2000 than was the case previously. That trend is consistent with the known increase in the longevity of the country as a whole.

The oldest recorded burial is that of Nicholas Elliot on the 30th August, 1602.

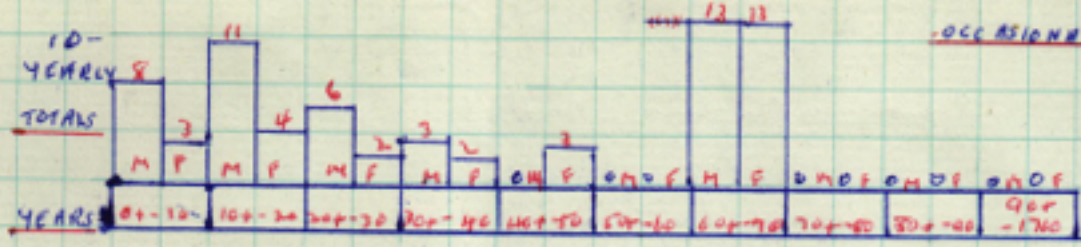

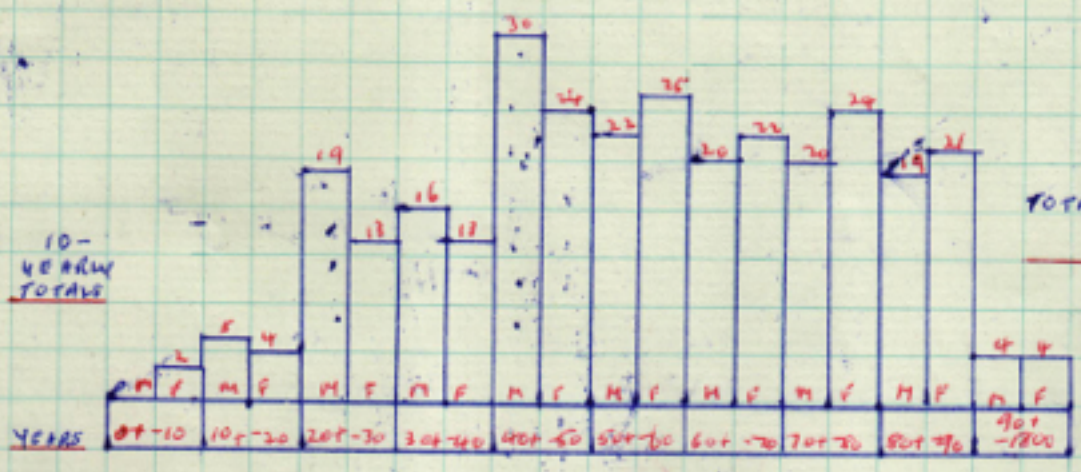

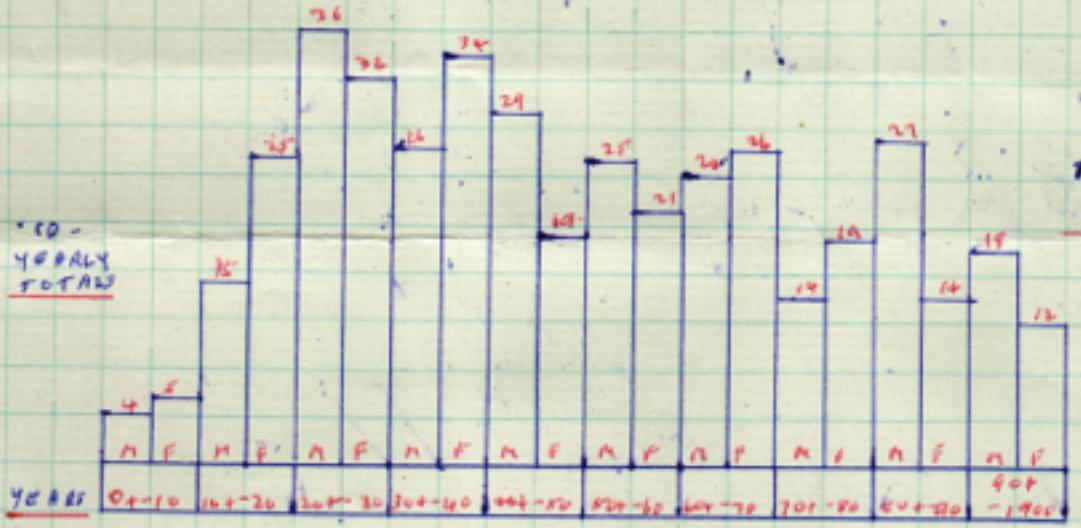
1700 - 1800

1800 - 1900

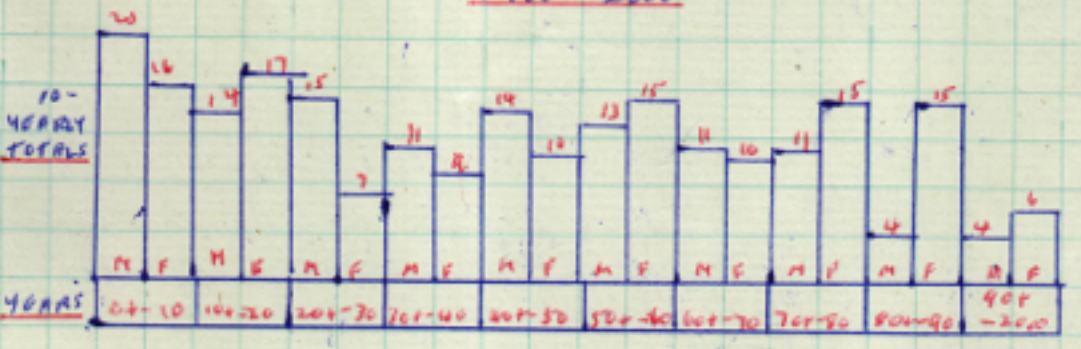
