It is to be shewed that John Stedon for these sundries for not  
coming to Church sundry more other dayes as are appointed for by  
divine service & for some recusants or absentees from church &  
by divine service was shewed no jury

2<sup>ly</sup> we know none but have received by parsonage by last year  
as for ojn words or sayings declared or spoken contemned by book  
of common prayer nor have we

3<sup>ly</sup> as for nonconformist. That is or any that doe stay or leave in  
conventicles or in house for no jury within the parish

4<sup>ly</sup> as for profane swearing & cursing and all such kindes or lewd  
sayings no jury within the parish

5<sup>ly</sup> we have enquired what order by all house keepers doe keep within  
the parish good or doe no order nor care to be used

6<sup>ly</sup> by number of all houses are two and we doe think no more  
but respect to are persons who are qualified by degrees to the Church

7<sup>ly</sup> we have received warrants on for John Stedon but for distress  
had not been taken and on warrant for nonconformist persons  
of which we have none within the parish nor none that doe stay

1. We do present John Stidston for three Sundays for not  
coming to Church Sundays nor other days as are appointed  
for divine service as for popish reticence or absentees  
from Church for divine service we have no such *recusants* ✓

*Secondly*

2. We know none but have received the sacrament for the last  
year(.) as for Spanish words or rhymes declared or spoken  
contested in books of common prayer we have no such *what?*  
*possibly 'contained in the book'*

*Thirdly*

3. As for nonconformist preachers or any that do preach or  
teach in conventicles or in their houses no such within  
the parish

4. As for profane swearers and cursers and alehouse haunTERS  
or lewd persons no such within the parish

5. We have enquired what order the alehouse keepers *why the ground?*  
within the parish do keep good order no cards no dice to be  
used

6. The number of alehouses are two and we do think no more  
necessary their persons well qualified, *the* by they repair  
to the Church every Sunday

7. We have received two warrants for John Stidston but for  
distress there can be none taken: and one warrant for  
nonconformist preachers of which we have none within the  
parish nor none that do frequent the parish
