- IN 1872 ORME BONSOR MARRIED GERTRUDE FELLOWES, DAUGHTER
OF JAMES FELLOWES(born 1814). ON THE DEATH OF EDWARD FELLOWES'
WIDOW, THE MANOR PASSED TO JAMES HERBERT FELLOWES
(James Herbert Benyon).
- 1907 SALE OF THE MANOR BY HENRY COSMO ORME BONSOR MP OF LONDON
AND JAMES HERBERT BENYON (previously James Herbert Fellowes) OF READING
TO GEORGE AND FRANK COYTE, BUTCHERS OF MODBURY, AND ARTHUR
CRAWLEY PODE, SOLICITOR OF MODBURY FOR THE SUM OF £15,000
