Billmen : James Yeabsley, Thomas Edward, Richard Godfrey, Francis Stabbs John Palmer, William Whyton, William Hatche, John Sollocke, Robert Tabbe, William Gaye

George Grimshaw gives the following information presumably from a modern text:

Land Possessors of yearly income :

£5 to £10 :1 almain rivet,1 bow, 1 sheaf of arrows, 1 steel cap, 1 bill

£10 to £20 : I almain rivet, 1 harquebus, 1 mosion (?), 1 sheaf of arrows, 1 steel cap, 1 bill

£20 to £40 : 1 corslet, 1 pike, 1 harquebus, 1 mosion, 1 bow, 1 sheaf of arrows, 1 steel cap

£40 to 100 : 2 corslets, 2 almainrivets, 2 pikes, 2 harquebuts, 2 morions, 1 bow, marks 1 sheaf of arrows, 1 steel cap

Goods to the value of :

£10 to £20 : 1 bow, 1 sheaf of arrows, 1 steel cap, 1 bill

£20 to £40 : 1 almain rivet, 2 bows, 2 sheafs of arrows, 2 steel caps 1 bill £40 to £100 : 2 almain rivets, 1 bow, 1 sheaf of arrows, 1 steel cap, 1 bill

s.cap stands for steel cap, there were 12 arrows in one sheaf
