The Bishop's Licence for the chapel is dated 2.9.1817. A Lease of Ringmore Vean to Hoopell, dated 1833, which is in the possession of Ringmore Historical Society, refers to the Meeting House. The Tithe Map of 1841 shows the building. "Cavalcade of History", which was published on 29.6.1857, mentions the chapel as:- "Baptist. Small Place of Worship but no Minister."
