

Appended to George Grimshaw's list of Overseers of the Poor is :

' April 1<sup>st</sup> 1771 : It is agreed this day by and between the Parishoners of the Parish of Ringmore and Mr. Richard Scoble who undertakes to provide Phisick and Medicenes for the sick poor of the Parish of Ringmore when as often as they shall stand in need of the same and midwifery if tis required from this day untill Easter next for the sum of two pound and twelve shilling and sixpence.
