Built in 1759 for the Lord of the Manor, Mr Francis Kirkham, as almshouses.

In 1840, converted to a cattle house and granary barn for the Higher Farm.
From about 1914 until 1944 used for cattle by

Mr George Luckraft of Pleasant Cottage Farm.

From 1944 until about 1962 used for cattle by

Mr J.C.May of Kimberley.
In 1922-74 converted to a dwelling for Mr and Mrs
John Borne. (Mrs Borne was a Granddaughter of Mr May).
