Built in about 1888 for John Crimp, formerly
farmer of Lower Farm. landlord of the New Inn.
(At one time called "Myrtle Cottage")

- 1888, 1897 John and Agnes Crimp Formerly farmer of Lower Farm: Whites
Tenant of Journey's End Inn
John died 1893 aged 89
Agnes died 1900
John Garland Crimp Son of John and Agnes
Clerk to Schoolboard
- 1902 John Garland Crimp Clerk to Schoolboard and
Attendance Officer
Died 1912 aged 76
- 1906, 1910 Mrs Forbes Kelly
(Widow of Alfred) Died 1912
- 1907 Cottage bought for renting by Bob Kerswell
Tenants:-
- 1912 Mr and Mrs John Parents of Dorothea Terry.
William Triggs Uncle of Alice Mason
Their sons James and and Margaret Lock
Philip and daughter Dorothea
Dorothea
- 1914-1934 Tom and Emma Julia Sub-Postmaster
Farley Tom was uncle of Alice Mason
and Flossie Bardens Died 1931
Emma was aunt of Flossie Bardens
and brought her up. Died 1957
- 1957-1965 Miss Flossie Bardens Parish Clerk
Died 1965
- 1961-1983 Mrs French Sister of Flossie Bardens
Brought up in Bude by aunt Mrs Ash
(Nee Bardens)
- 1983-1986 Mr and Mrs Hernden Formerly Postmaster at Ivy Cottage
Moved to Modbury
Owner of two cottages, converted to one
- 1986- David and Andrea Young
