- No 2 Tuckers -Mr,Mrs, Sandra and brother (can't remember his name)
- No 3 Johns Mrs. : Sylvia, Elizabeth, Simon (I think) and another brother
I think Mr. Johns might have been away at sea ?????
I used to play with Elizabeth. Think Mrs. Johns might be b
Buried in Ringmore churchyard as Elizabeth returns to visit
- No 4 Bowdens Mr., Mrs., Hiram and Richard moved in when houses were
first built . Mr. Bowden worked on the greens at the golf
Club in Bigbury. Hiram is 'car specialist repairs' at Ashford,
Aveton Gifford and Richard, I think, is in building at Aveton
Gifford.
- No 5 Freemans I can't remember much about this house - only a Mr.
Mr. Freeman - there were no children of my age to play with.
- No 6 Parents I played with Rita and her younger sister not sure of how
many others were living there but think her grandparents
were there - same family still in residence today.
- No 7 Hine Mr and Mrs. David, John and Rosemary (me)
- No 8 Bucks Mr ; Mrs ; Wendy & Jonathan (was there another sister or
Brother?) . Mrs.Buck OPENED a small shop - a challet type
building connected at the top (on left) of cockle house -
where entrance to fields are now.

- NO 1. MR MOORE (+ DAUGHTER URSULA - she married about this time - now MARILYN THORNTON - living at (Coombe) Avelon Gifford Tel 830738. (don't remember a "Mrs Moore")
- NO 2. TUCKERS - MR, MRS, SANDRA AND BROTHER (can't remember his name) I used to play with Sandra
- NO 3. SOHNS MRS: SYLVIA, ELIZABETH, SIMON (I think) and another brother. I think Mr Sohns might have been away at sea ???
Seafaring - I used to play with Elizabeth. Think Mrs Sohns might be buried in Rymiscs Church Yard as Elizabeth returns to visit -
- NO 4. BOWDENS. MR: MRS: HIRAM AND RICHARD. Moved in when houses were first built. Mr Bowden worked on the greens at the golf club at Bigbury. Hiram is "cat specialist repairs" at Avelon Gifford + Richard I think is in building at Avelon Gifford? Mrs Bowden lives in that area too.
- NO 5. FREEMANS - I can't remember much about this house - only a Mr Freeman - there were no children of my age to play with! -
- NO 6. PARENTS. I played with RITA and her younger sister not sure of how many others were living there but think her Grandparents were there - same family still in residence today.
- NO 7 - HINE. MR. MRS. DAVID, JOHN + ROSEMARY (me.)
- NO 8. BUCKS MR: MRS: WENDY + SWATHAN (was there another sister or brother?) Mrs Buck opened a small shop - a chalet type building annexed at the top (on left) of Cockle Lane - where entrance to fields are now -
