

RAYNOR AGAINST JULIAN : 29 July 1791

Estates of John Julian, late of Eggbuckland, Clerk, Deceased

LOT XXXIV

A Freehold Estate in the Parish of Ringmore in the said County consisting of a Farm House, barn, stable, outhouses, two orchards and about 38 A[acres ?] of land, held by William Stidson under a lease of 7 years, six of which were unexpired at Michaelmas last, at the yearly rent of £38

LOT XLII

Freehold Estate : (Renton?)

Farmhouse, Orchard and 14 acres of land in possession of Mr. Sparrow as tenant to John Skinner held by lease dated 26 Dec. 1740 upon life of John Skinner aged 61 rent 11s.

LOT XLIX

Freehold estate consisting of a Farm House, Barn and Stable, Outhouses, Orchard and about 49 acres of landing parish of Ringmore called by name of Markewill otherwise Renton. Also Two Fields of about an Acre and a half in the parish of Kingston called by name of Striveland Green in the poss. Of Richard Hamlyn held by lease date 7 Apr. 1768 upon three lives of Mry Prideaux aged 53 years, Richard Hamlyn aged 71 years and George Hamlyn aged 52 years. Rent £1 10s. p.a.

LOT L

Freehold Estate situated in Parish of Ringmore called by name of Markewill otherwise Little Renton, consisting of a tenement in Renton with about 13 A of land in possession of Richard Hamlyn held on lease dated 7 April 1768 upon 3 lives. Arthur Hamlyn aged 54 years, Elisabeth Steer aged 71 years, Susanna Hamlyn Lagger aged 52 years. Rent 7s.6d p.a.
