
Meeting at The Journey's End on Friday 12 November at 7.30 p.m.

The Rector writes ..

" Walter, Walter ... "

Marriages in rural areas are quite an event - as much as anything because there are so few of them and, since everyone knows everyone, they are real community events into the bargain. By contrast, in my previous parish in Swindon there were nearly one thousand weddings in my time there and I had the opportunity of talking about marriage with many hundreds of young people. It was a great privilege to share in their excitement at the prospect of committing themselves to each other in God's sight and in the presence of their family and friends.

I reckon that the old Wedding Service has had as great an influence on the social life of this country as anything one can think of - tho' you certainly wouldn't think so from the treatment that marriage seems to get nowadays in the media. When did you last see a happily married couple making love on the telly?

Mind you, there's nothing soppy about the Christian view of marriage - the Wedding Service is strong and uncompromising and the vows call for nothing less than "unconditional surrender" to each other. The relationship in marriage is essentially personal, but the recognition of marriage is public; its' part - and, I think, a vitally important part - of how our society holds together.

NOTES OF PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY 7TH SEPTEMBER 1993

- * Devon County Council Highways Department Officer will proceed with repainting 'SLOW' signs on the road through the village, adding a new sign warning that pedestrians use the road, and erecting a new chevron sign near the church wall to warn drivers of the sharp bend. Pedestrians are advised to be on the lookout for traffic, and when walking through the village to keep to the outside of any bend.
- * Representation is to be made to the County Council over problems caused by heavy goods vehicles.
- * The Commission reviewing parliamentary constituency boundaries has recommended that Ringmore Parish will form part of the 'South West Devon' constituency. The Parish Council agreed to make representation at the Inquiry on 2nd November to seek to transfer to the 'Totnes' constituency and to seek a meeting with Councillor Squire to explore tactics.
- * The planning application for eleven cottages at the Challacott Centre, submitted by Haven Warner, was considered and unanimously opposed.
- * The next meeting will take place at 7.00p.m. on <u>Wednesday</u> 6th October (note, not Tuesday). All are welcome. There is always a slot for you to express your views or ask questions.


