On Ash Wednesday itself, Mar.1st., we share a Communion service at Kingston church, 7.30pm. In the following weeks, the Lent meetings will be on Thursday evenings, 7.30pm in Ringmore Church Hall.

So on Mar.9th we welcome John Cole, Vicar of Modbury. John is Team Rector designate and has been in Modbury since 1987. A Chartered Accountant working in the engineering industry, John came into the ordained ministry in 1980. John and Elizabeth have two daughters.

In 1994, Roderick Withnell came to us as Team Vicar - with Loddiswell, Woodleigh & E.Allington his particular charge. Of Scottish descent, Roderick worked in advertising before ordination in 1990. He and Alison have a young son and live now in Loddiswell. We welcome him on March 16th.

Nearer home, Mar.23rd sees Michael Tagent speaking to us. He and Jackie live now in Ringmore, tho' Michael continues, mid-week, his work as a Chartered Accountant in an engineering firm. He has been a Reader for over 25 years, starting in the Embassy Church, Paris. Michael & Jackie have two daughters and a son.

Our fourth speaker is not a prospective member of the formal team, but a number of his church members live in Bigbury parish and share in our house meetings. David and Lynne Slater have four children and have been in Kingsbridge nearly 16 years, where he is minister of Kingsbridge Baptist Church. Having graduated in applied chemistry, David came into full-time ministry via work among students in Birmingham University. He concludes our series on Thurs.Mar.30th.

**\* TRAFFIC CALMING**

Clls. Eddy, Tate, Bennett and Mc Cabe had met Paul Marshall from Devon County Council earlier in the day to discuss a variety of rumble devices. Councillors agreed to proceed with a number of silver/grey rumble strips which do not protrude too high thus being safe for cyclists but cause a vibration to vehicles. This will cost less than £500 and costs will be shared between the Parish Council and Devon County Council.

The council considered an application for continued use of Auglen Fell and recommended continued use for a five year period.

**\* ANNIVERSARY**

No suggestions had so far been received to celebrate 100 years of the Parish Council.

**\* HEDGE CUTTING**

It was agreed to arrange for the hedges to be cut down Challaborough Hill early in July.



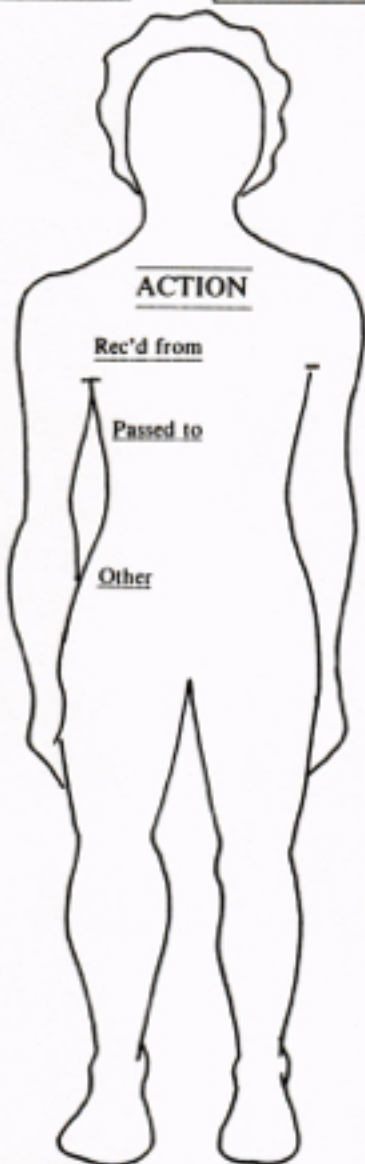
