Lethbridge.. Some cousin of Alice's Granny Triggs her mother was Granny Freeman.

Flossie - Mrs. French's sister- they had an uncle called Farley- no relation to Alice

Alice born in Well Cottage till 14 years.. Alice's grandfather in bed in kitchen

David Triggs - Carpenter and undertaker

James Triggs -garden & sextant (Does George mean 'gardener' and 'sexton')

Spring Cottage - Mary Ann Bartlett : Alice's father's auntie

11. Alice's father lived with his father and mother until married then moved to No.2' Cumberland Cott.

14. Granny Triggs sister Sarah Ryder and son-in-law lived there. Sarah Ryder's daughter lived in Hill Cottage -Mrs. Freeman. (Against 'son-in-law' is written 'Middle Manor'.)

17. Alice used to milk seven cows in almshouses. Are these the front of the Bourne house ?

Midwife : Mrs. Elizabeth Freeman, sister to Margaret's granny
